NLS ATTENDANCE AND LATE POLICY 2022-2023

It is the policy of Northern Lakes School to ensure that students are in regular attendance and that unexcused absences are kept to a minimum. Regular attendance is one of the most important components of a successful experience at school; this has been well documented in educational research.

Attendance

- 1. Student attendance will be tracked by the classroom teacher and the office. Students must provide a note or a phone call from their parent/guardian explaining all absences. Parents/guardians are encouraged to call the office in advance where at all possible when they are aware of an upcoming student absence.
- 2. Extended absences such as illnesses or family trips may be excused by the Principal. **Parents/guardians** must call in advance and speak to administration about these absences.
- 3. Excused absences include all school-sponsored activities, including field trips, sports, Outers, and team activities.
- 4. Teachers will communicate with parents when they have concerns regarding a student's attendance and their achievement.

Lates

- Students are to be in class on time. There are 10-minute transitions between classes and a warning bell rings 4 minutes prior to class starting. This is ample time for students to pick up books, make phone calls, and take washroom breaks.
- 2. If a student accumulates 5 lates to a class, the classroom teacher will assign an appropriate consequence. (eg. detention).
- 3. If a student accumulates excessive lates (5-10+), the classroom teacher will make contact with the parent/guardian by phone, letter, and/or email, and appropriate consequences will be assigned.
- 4. Excessive lateness to classes may result in a referral to the Principal and/or the Guidance Counselor for further contact home and possible parent/guardian meeting.

Students who accumulate excessive absences/lates that are not legitimate or excused by the Principal may be removed from the course or program. Parents/guardians are encouraged to use the PowerSchool Parent Portal to stay updated on their teen's attendance.
